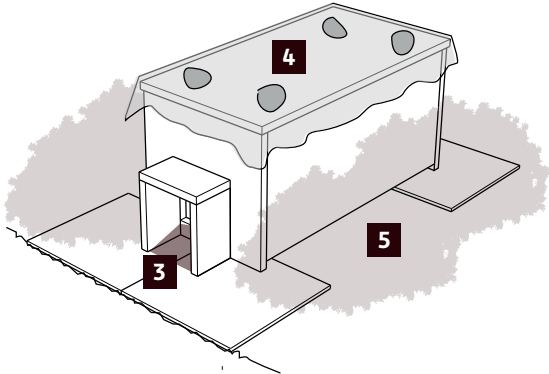


Installation instructions

- 1
- Select a dry, dark spot under a large shrub in a quiet part of the garden. Set four paving slabs (or another hard surface) slightly into the ground. Place the box on top.
- *The box can also be placed directly on dry ground, but placing it on slabs increases its service life.



- 2
- Fill the inside of the box approximately halfway with dry leaves and/or paper shreds. Make sure the material is completely dry, otherwise mould can form quickly.
- 3
- Finish the entrance with a little sand/leaves to reduce the step.



- 4
- Optionally place a piece of tarp over the box and secure it with stones.
- 5
- Finish around the box with dry leaves/branches so that it blends into the garden as much as possible. Ensure sufficient ventilation around the box, otherwise this will affect the service life of the box.
